

TSCA K-12TH DRESS CODE STANDARD

SHIRTS

- Only solid Black, Red or Grey **UNIFORM** polo shirts (short or long sleeved)
 - o Long-sleeved undershirts in the solid color of black, red, grey or white may be worn underneath the polo.
 - o Large logos and/or wording is not permitted.
- All shirts should fit properly. To maintain modesty, tops must be long enough to ensure no part of
 the midriff is exposed, whether sitting, raising arms, or bending over, and that no undergarments
 are visible.

PANTS, SHORTS, SKIRTS

- Khaki or Black **UNIFORM** pants, shorts, and skirts.
- Must fit properly. Proper fit is defined as fitting to form without putting stress on any area of the pants as seen by the pulling of fabric or zipper.
- Must be without any holes or fraying.
- All shorts and skirts must have a 7 9 inch inseam, landing at mid-thigh or below. A helpful guideline is to make sure the bottom of the skirt/shorts extend beyond the middle fingertip while standing with arms extended straight down at your side.

LEGGINGS/TIGHTS

• Girls may wear full-length, solid black or white tights or leggings ONLY <u>under their skirts or gym</u> <u>shorts</u>. Leggings may not be worn as stand-alone pants.

SWEATERS, SWEATSHIRTS

- Solid or combination of Red, Black, White or Grey pullover (crew neck or V-neck), cardigan-style and quarter-zip sweaters and sweatshirts are acceptable.
 - o Large logos and/or wording is not permitted with the exception of TSCA Logos.

OUTERWEAR

• Non-Uniform outerwear items are not allowed to be worn in school between the hours of 8:00AM-3:00PM. This includes coats and jackets.

FOOTWARE

- Open-toe footwear is prohibited.
- Athletic shoes with a non-marking sole are required for gym class.

ACCESSORIES

• Hats or head coverings of any kind are not permitted to be worn in school.

GENERAL APPEARANCE AND GROOMING

- Dress neatly: All clothes are to be free of tears, holes and stains and appropriately sized for the wearer.
- Unusual haircuts, color or styles that would draw undue attention to a student are not permitted.
- ALL students must maintain a natural color of hair. Dyed or colored hair outside natural hair colors will not be permitted.
- Ear piercings are permitted. The appropriateness of display of any other body piercings will be decided at the discretion of the school administration.
- Adhere to the dress standards appropriate for the event. Students that do not adhere to the dress standards for any event will not be allowed to participate in that event.
- Tattoos may be asked to be covered.

GYM UNIFORM: All students in Kindergarten through 8th grade as well as any High School Student taking P.E. or playing a sport, will need a gym uniform. This includes the P.E. Uniform shirt and shorts, the sweatpants may also be worn, but are not required. Orders must be placed through the online shopping link on our website.

FRIDAY-WEAR

- Each Friday students are permitted to wear jean pants or shorts with any TSCA Spirit top.
- Shorts must follow uniform length rule.
- Jeans/shorts must fit properly and be free from any tears/holes.

DRESS DOWN DAYS

Occasionally students are allowed to wear casual, non-uniform clothes. This is considered a privilege. Students are expected to arrive to school in modest dress down apparel. Please note the specific "dress down" guidelines below.

- All clothes must be modest and in good condition
- No inappropriate/disrespectful graphics or text
- No tank tops, sleeveless shirts, midriff bearing shirts
- No leggings/jeggings, ripped jeans or pajama pants
- No hats or head coverings, except on specific days that call for them.

ENFORCEMENT

- 1st offense written warning
- 2nd offense infractions issued
- 3rd offense conference with administration, detention
- Students out of uniform may be asked to change at the discretion of the administration.
